ardent prayer, and let us pray feeling that the bombs are falling on our own families, our children, brothers and friends... let us pray without covering our eyes and ears... and let us do it in peace, unarmed of revenge, with the sword of faith 'against all hope'....

I invite you to sit with Mary, as in that Cenacle of Pentecost, when they were still afraid, and the doors were closed. I invite you to light a lamp as the Family of Carmel, to place ourselves before the Lord in adoration or rosary in hand, or in the silence of communion....

Holy Mary, Queen of Peace, silence the war and give us peace among our brothers and sisters, your children.
